## Maintenance & Care Guide

#### Simple advice on how to keep your Easigrass<sup>™</sup> looking fantastic for years to come

#### Furniture

The use of Garden Furniture, Trampolines and Swimming/Paddling Pools is safe on Easigrass™ however we recommend the following guidelines:

- Do not place garden furniture with sharp, thin metal or thin pointed legs onto Easigrass<sup>™</sup> as this increases the risk of piercing and damage.
- Regularly move garden furniture around the area preventing crushing and pressure marks.
- The above guidelines also apply for Trampolines which we recommend moving around the area to also prevent crushing and pressure marks.
- Swimming and paddling pools present a potential risk with the refraction of Ultra Violet Light through the water which can burn the Easigrass<sup>™</sup> product directly beneath.
- The above Ultra Violet Light risk also applies to mirrors, water features and UV reflective glass.

#### Miscellaneous

- The use of a vacuum cleaner is not recommended as this will remove sand infill.
- BBQ's present a potential heat damage risk to the product so they are not recommended to be used directly on top of the area.
- Do not use bleach and/or non-Easigrass™ recommended products and cleaners.
- The use of a power washer and/or power hose is not recommended.

#### **General** Dirt

The removal of general dirt is achieved by using a stiff yard brush along with warm water and a mild detergent in a watering can and/or bucket.

#### Weeds & Moss

- Easily controlled as long as it is treated regularly.
- Weed and moss growth needs to be treated with a product recommended by Easigrass™.
- DIY outlets, builder's merchants and hardware stores stock a range of weed and moss control products. Always take care to follow the manufacturer's instructions and seek the approval from Easigrass<sup>™</sup> before proceeding.

#### Pets

Easigrass<sup>™</sup> is 100% pet friendly however we recommend you follow some simple maintenance guidelines.

- Use a stiff yard brush to remove any pet hair which builds on the area.
- Heavy use for urine is not recommended however for light use we recommend treating affected areas with our specialist Easi-Pong product which will remove any smells and bacteria.
- Defecation should be treated equally the same as with natural grass and removed with an implement that will not damage Easigrass<sup>™</sup>. As with urine we recommend treating affected areas with our specialist Easi-Pong product.
